The timber is rotting, in places they leak a lot of water and are generally quite damp and unsecure with one side of one of the buildings being open fronted. The shed we propose replacing these with will be built using modern materials, a lot more aesthetically pleasing and require a lot less maintenance. The use of the building will not change and will remain a storage area for farm machinery &amp; produce</i> <b>ii. 23/2776N - Stoke Hall Farm, Stoke Hall Lane, Stoke:</b> <i>Variation of Conditions 7 &amp; 15 on 21/6359N - Demolition of barns and conversion of agricultural building to create 7 residential dwellings with ancillary garages along with access and landscaping.</i>
